2) Forms can be printed and sent by post, by hand, or completed using the fill and sign option within Acrobat PDF readers or equivalent. Typed names in lieu of handwritten signatures will be accepted, but still binding.

4) Payment can be by cash, cheque, or PayPal. Cheques should be payable to Duddon Canoe Club. PayPal payments should be made using the email address of dccjmck@gmail.com, ensuring you use the "Send to Someone You Trust" option to eliminate PayPal fees.

5) **IF YOU DO NOT FOLLOW THESE SIMPLE REQUESTS** your membership may be significantly delayed, whilst we sort out the details.

6) A new form must be completed for each new membership and for renewals of membership each year.

7) Family Membership covers partners or individuals and those under 18 for whom they are responsible.

8) Under 18's are permitted to be individual members. They may paddle unaccompanied at the discretion of the Coach leading the session. However, a responsible adult must accompany them at the start and end of a session. If for any reason they leave the site whilst the paddler is on the water, a Mobile Telephone number must be filled in on the signing in sheet for emergency purposes.

9) **Medical Conditions** must be reported to the Coach leading the Club Session or Event. It is the responsibility of the paddler or responsible adult to ensure that all relevant medical conditions are disclosed prior to paddling at each event or session. The paddler must carry any medication that may be required. In the case of Juniors, the coach may be asked if they would carry the medication.

How your information will be used

Club Communications

We may send you club communications not associated directly with your membership administration (i.e., club trips) only if you have explicitly opted in by ticking the box previous.

Duddon Canoe Club Membership – What do I get?

DCC is affiliated to British Canoeing. As a member of DCC you have:-

Access to club sessions at our dock base (with over 100 different canoes and kayaks), use of club equipment, kitchen and changing facilities, ergo training equipment and coach lead / supervised sessions on the water. The on the water fee of £1 helps cover the rent and rates for the site of about £780 pa,

Access to club pool session – we have 20 Kayaks kept at Barrow pool where members can learn new skills, brush up old skills, play polo or just have fun.

Club events on local lakes, rivers and sea and the training to equip you to join these events.

For those club members who are not individual members of British Canoeing DCC pay a fee to British Canoeing to cover insurance costs. This fee (£2.20 for adults) makes you an Associate Member of British Canoeing.

What do I get as an Associate Member of British Canoeing?

You are covered by British canoeing insurance to attend events run by DCC, the local BC team – Cumbria Canoeists - Joint activities with other clubs and entry level events run by or for the national discipline committees like Marathon races, river races, slalom events and local polo leagues. (£5 each for non-club members).

To take part in some of the competitive events you may need to show proof of associate membership. In order to do this we need to add your membership details to the DCC British Canoeing Club Portal (name DOB email). You will be able to access your details but they will only be able to be seen by you and 3 club officials (sec. head coach. Membership sec.) By being registered on the portal you will be able to access your BC membership number, BC news emails and BC members offers and enter events online where offered. You will also have access to the BC 'GoMembership' facility where you can record any canoe courses/qualifications/first aid/ safeguarding that you have. This information will go on to the club portal. (to help the head coach see that our club coaches and leaders are up to date).

Families – all family members can be entered on the portal but only one email address is needed (DOBs are needed determine the age groups for affiliation fee and race entries)

-It is **not** a requirement of DCC membership that your details are added to the BC portal-you will still be an associate member for insurance purpose. You will be asked if you wish to be added to the club BC Portal when you renew your annual club membership.

Club Associate Membership

What is a Club Associate?

A Club Associate is a member of an British Canoeing affiliated club, for whom the club has paid a capitation fee

How much does my club pay for my Club Associate membership?

For adults, your club pays British Canoeing £2.20, for juniors your club pays £1.20

What do I get?

Insurance for all of your club activity plus access to entry level British Canoeing events and competitions

Does it include a waterways licence?

No, if you are using your own craft on managed waterways you will need a licence. If your club sessions are on a waterway that requires a licence, your club should have purchased licences for each of their club owned craft.

Can I paddle outside of club sessions?

Sure! However, you won't be covered by your Club Associate insurance. You can get insurance and a waterways licence by becoming an [On The Water member](#)

What counts as club activity?

Any activity that has been assessed as part of the club's safety framework and promoted on the club calendar, website or noticeboard. Club activities also include inter-club activities where the responsibility for risk assessment and management is carried out and shared between all participating clubs

Can I coach?

Your Club Associate insurance covers you for leading or coaching club activity. You are not covered to lead or coach outside club activity. If you want to make sure you have adequate insurance cover for coaching and leading outside of club activity, you are advised to join as an [On The Water member](#) or purchase your own insurance that includes professional indemnity cover
