Adverse weather conditions	All Paddlers users and visitors Exposure	Paddlers provided with appropriate paddle sport equipment such as wetsuits, cags, waterproofs & pogies as required.	Constant supervision by coaches of paddlers and weather conditions <i>(equipment such as hats and gloves, sun cream will be provided by the paddlers and not the club)</i>	Coaches & responsible users	On going

Slip, trips or falls	All people attending Ramsden dock base Cuts, bruises & abrasions	Supervision, information, instruction & training to all paddlers and visitors Information in place on notice boards	Seasonal dangers such as ice in the winter and sea weed and shells in the summer to be explained to users	Coaches & responsible users	On going
Equipment	All paddlers and coaches Head injuries	All participants use helmets when taking part in canoe polo, standing up rafting games/gunnel bobbing or any other game where there is a risk of head injury. Novice and U16 to use helmets on SUP's	Coaches carrying out sessions to ensure that paddlers are wearing the correct equipment for the session	Coaches & responsible users	On going
